



BIRTH AND POSTPARTUM CARE

A doula is a trained professional who provides emotional and physical support to a woman before, during, and after childbirth. Doulas offer education and information to help expectant mothers make informed decisions about their care.

During childbirth, a doula can provide massage, breathing techniques, and positioning suggestions to help the mother cope with the pain of labor. Doulas can offer emotional support by providing encouragement, listening, and helping the mother and her partner communicate with hospital staff.

After childbirth, a doula can assist with breastfeeding and getting the baby on a sleeping and eating schedule. Postpartum services can also include meal preparation, light housekeeping, and caring for older siblings.

A doula's main role is to support the mother's wishes and needs and to help her feel empowered and confident.

Our Screening Process

We carefully screen our applicants to ensure the safety of your children. All Candidates have undergone the following 11-tier Screening Process:

- 2. Reference Checks and Former Employment Verified
- 3. Social Media Review
- 4. Phone Interview
- 5. Personal Interviews with the Agency
- 6. State and County Background Screening (Criminal and Civil)
- 7. Nationwide Sexual Misconduct Record
- 8. Department of Motor Vehicle Driving Record Checked
- 9. Social Security Verification
- 10. Residency History
- 11. Training and Certification (Infant/Child CPR and First Aid Certifications)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



Do you provide date night and occasional sitter services?

We provide local sitter services at a residence, hotel, or Airbnb.

All of our sitters have at least 2 years of professional experience. We have sitters who are experienced in childcare, as well as sitters who have experience caring for infants. Each sitter has provided us with babysitting or nannying references, and we diligently check each of these references to ensure they are positive. Our sitters are CPR certified, have a clean driving record, and are background checked.

To partake in this service, we charge a \$150 Membership Fee. After this initial fee, we charge a sitter placement fee of \$30 per day that a sitter is utilized (additional fees may apply).

Do you provide overnight care services for families?

Yes, we provide services any time of day from an overnight to a vacation. Overtime and double-time rates do apply. We can split a weekend or overnight shift between two care providers to minimize overtime fees. If you are hiring a long-term nanny and anticipate needing regular overnight care, be sure that this is well-defined in your agreement and that you ask your nanny about her overnight availability well in advance.

How should I pay my caregiver on a Long-Term Placement?

Nannies are paid an hourly rate and should receive their compensation weekly or biweekly. You are responsible for any applicable tax, withholding, and reporting. A payroll company can help you with that. You will want to work with a payroll company that deals with domestic workers. We recommend using GTM Payroll Services for your nanny payroll- it is one of the best domestic payroll processing services in the country.

Additionally, we recommend consulting with your CPA or a Domestic Employment Attorney to give your family the best advice.
